Town Council

Administration

- Disaster recovery plan in place

Access and Highways

- To continue to provide free parking in the town centre
- New housing and employment developments to have adequate off street parking
- To ensure traffic travel within the speed limit
- To ensure the weight limit of 7.5 tonne for the town centre is adhered to

Land and Properties

- The Market House is used by the community and is financially sustainable
- Continue to explore the asset transfer of the Market House from SSDC to CCTC
- Support the development of Caryford Hall as a community space to be available for use by all residents
- To ensure the retail zone will continue to flourish
- The Fairfield will be owned jointly by CCTC and APC
- Continue the development of the Fairfield as a recreational area
