SOUTH SOMERSET ORDER 2012
(AMENDMENT NO. 5) ORDER 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Somerset County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') as amended; and the Traffic Management Act 2004, (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 2004') as amended, and all other enabling powers.

The effect will result in changes to the parking and waiting restrictions in the following locations:

Ash: Main Street

Broadway: Lamparts Way

Bruton: Cuckoo Hill, Silver Street, Patwell Street

Brympton: Alvington Lane, Boundary Road, Edward Close, Stourton Way, Thorne Lane, Warrior Avenue

Castle Cary: Chapel Close, Upper High Street, Market Place

Chard: Duck Lane, Fore Street, Glynswood, Holyrood Street, Morangis Way

Crewkerne: Blacknell Lane, Kithill, Market Street, Thomson Drive

Huish Episcopi: Meadow Close, St Mary's Park

Ilchester: Layby off Northover

Ilminster: Court Barton, West Street, Winterhay Lane

Martock: Church Street, East Street, North Street, Old Market

Milborne Port: North Street, Station Road

Montacute: Middle Street, South Street

Somerton: Behind Berry and West Street, Gassons Lane, North Street, Behind Berry, Sutton Road

Stoke-Sub-Hamdon: Hamdon Close

Wincanton: Church Street, High Street

Yeovil: Addlewell Lane, Alastair Drive, Bell Chase, Birchfield Road, Carisbrooke Gardens, Harbin Close, Lime Tree Avenue, Marsh Lane, Meadow Road, Mudford Road, Preston Road, Rowan Way, St James's Park, St John's Road, West Hendford, Westland Road, Seaton Road, West Street, Wraxhill Road, West Coker Road

Yeovil Without: Cavalier Way, Tower Road
