TC70 Apologies for absence

TC72 To agree the appointment of Tim Taylor – Foot Anstey as legal adviser to Castle Cary Town Council for the Inquiry into Appeal APP/R3325/W/20/3259668 for the proposed development of 200 houses North of Ansford Hill

Secondly, he would advise the 4 groups CCTC, APC, NH Plan and C4C making representations with topics and content. It has been agreed that CCTC and APC will split his costs on a 50/50 basis. Wessex Water plans discussed. JH is writing to the Inspectorate proposing that the venue is Caryford Hall.

Resolved: A vote was taken and it was agreed to offer two jobs - a Market Manager and a Porter.
